

Harvest Middle School and River School Dress Policy

1. All **tops** must not allow undergarments such as t-shirts, bras, boxer type shorts to show. All tops must cover shoulders to the edge of the shoulder. No mesh, see-through, strapless, spaghetti straps or overly revealing shirts may be worn. Staff members determine whether or not a shirt is “too revealing.”
2. **Tops:** patterns are acceptable. No reds in clothing are acceptable.
3. **Shorts/skirts** must extend beyond the tips of fingers when arms are hanging normally on the student’s sides. In addition, a teacher or staff member will determine that shorts/skirts are “too short” or too revealing even if they meet the policy criteria.
4. All **pants** must fit around the waist without a belt, must be hemmed and must not touch the ground. Bottoms must not sag, drag, or bag. (**Underwear must not show.**) **No red or whites.**
5. **Clothing/outfits** that reveal an individual’s midsection must not be worn to school. When a student is standing up straight and extends his/her arms parallel to the ground, the clothing must not reveal their mid-section. In addition the midsection may not show during normal school activities. If it does, then either the pants are too low or the top is too short.
6. **Clothing** shall **not** have logos, pictures or writing except River School and Harvest Middle School spirit wear and academic teams.
7. **Hats:** Not acceptable on campus, but may be worn to and from school. Sweatshirt Hoods, bandanas, or hairnets are **not** allowed to be worn.
8. **Shoes:** 2 inch max height of heels or soles. No flip-flops can be worn.
9. **Jackets:** May have a brand logo, but no professional sports team logos or logo meant for the purpose of intimidation or identification. Logos can only be school designated colors.
10. **Restricted items** include any symbols which identify groups for intimidation or illegal purposes, are a distraction to the learning environment, or take away from the educational process. **Examples** include but not limited to, black trench coats, any unusual hair color or hair style, spiked jewelry, piercing other than earlobes, skin tattoos/skin graffiti, hanging belts or chains.
11. A student forum will be established to advise the administration on the dress policy.
